So — What Exactly is a Dental Implant?

A dental implant is a small titanium post that is placed into your jawbone to act as a permanent replacement root for a missing tooth. Once it has integrated with the bone — a process that takes a few months (if you do not have enough bone to work with) — a crown (the visible tooth) is attached on top, giving you a result that looks, feels, and functions exactly like a natural tooth.

Unlike dentures or bridges, implants are permanent, do not affect adjacent teeth, and preserve the natural bone in your jaw. For most people, they are the gold standard solution for missing teeth.

The All-on-6 — What Does it Actually Mean?

If you are missing most or all your teeth in one or both arches (top and/or bottom), the All-on-6 is one of the most transformative procedures available. Here is what the process looks like in plain English:

1	Initial Assessment & Planning Dr. Anand will use advanced 3D imaging (CBCT) to assess your bone density and jaw structure. A full treatment plan is created — nothing is guesswork.
2	Extractions (if needed) Any remaining teeth that need to be removed are extracted — this is included in the All-on-6 pricing quoted.
3	Six Implants are Placed Six titanium implant posts are precisely positioned into the jawbone, distributed to maximise stability and bone contact.
4	Temporary Teeth Fitted In most cases, a temporary set of teeth is fitted the same day, so you are never without a smile.
5	Healing & Integration Over the following months, the implants fuse with the jawbone — a natural process called osseointegration. This is what makes implants so durable.
6	Permanent Arch Fitted Once integration is complete, your permanent, custom-made arch of teeth is fitted. The result is a full, natural-looking smile that is fixed, stable, and long-lasting.

Recovery — What to Expect

Timeline	What to Expect
Days 1–3	Some swelling and tenderness is completely normal. Soft foods only. Pain is manageable with prescribed medication. Rest is important.
Days 3–7	Swelling settles. You will feel increasingly comfortable. Continue soft diet and follow Dr. Anand's oral hygiene instructions carefully.
Weeks 2–6	Most people return to normal daily activities. Diet can gradually broaden. The implants are quietly integrating with your bone — an amazing natural process.
Months 3–6 (if not enough bone in first visit)	Final permanent arch is fitted (for All-on-6 patients). Your smile is complete. With proper care, your implants will last a lifetime.
